Preferred Hooks: Leeches/Sculpins: Mustad 79580 Streamer
Beads/Eggs: Mustad C67S egg hook
Mice/Stimulators: Daiichi 1270 York bend

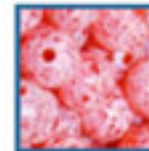
Egg-Sucking Crystal Leech
Sz. 8 - 4
Colors: Black, Purple



Articulated Bunny Leech
Sz. 4 - 1/0
Colors: Black, Brown, Ginger



Egg Imitations
Glo-Bugs, Beads
Hook Sz. 8 - 6



Flesh Flies
Bunny Leeches
Sz. 8 - 4
Color: White, Brown

Sculpin Imitations, weighted
sz. 8 - 4
Colors: Black, Olive, Ginger



Battle Creek Special
Sz. 10 - 6
Colors: Orange, Pink



Topwater Flies
Mouse Imitations, Stimulators,
Sofa Pillows
Sz. 12 - 4



Notes: We weight all leech and sculpin patterns with 6 - 10 wraps of lead wire part-way towards the front of the hook, or weight with dumbbell eyes. This produces a natural diving or undulating action and allows these flies to sink to the bottom where we need them in order to produce big 'bows'. Flesh & egg patterns are typically lightly weighted or unweighted as we want to create a natural floating presentation with the stream current. Split shot can be added 8 - 12 inches up leader to allow a deeper presentation. Topwater flies can be drifted, stripped or skated and produce very aggressive strikes.
